

Ordinance #03-10-14

Allowing Sales of Alcohol in Closed Containers by "Class B" Licensed Holders

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Florence

Florence County

The Town Board of the Town of Florence, Florence County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s 125.51 (3) (b), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance. This ordinance replaces Ordinance No. 33 dated November 12th, 1963.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides that any holder of a "Class B" intoxicating liquor license may sell intoxicating liquor in the original package or container, in multiples not to exceed 4 liters at any one time, for consumption off the premises where sold.

The Town Florence further clarifies that the number of "Class B" licenses which are subject to a state-imposed quota of December 1, 1997 is 18 (Eighteen) and 3 (Three) Reserve "Class B" licenses available.


This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s 60.80, Wis. Stats.




