Acceptable Material:

- Clean Oil
- Metal
- Compost
- Batteries
- Dried Empty Paint Cans
- Oil Filters
- Appliances —including refrigerators, freezers, microwaves, humidifiers, dehumidifiers and air conditions (\$10 each)
- Car & Light Truck Tires (\$6 each without rim, \$8 each with rim)
- Mattresses (\$20 each)
- Furniture— Only Florence & Commonwealth may dispose of furniture.

Non-Acceptable Material:

- Bags of garbage and solid waste garbage
- Items that can fit into solid waste bag and can be placed with a sticker for weekly garbage pickup
- Construction and demolition debris (must be disposed of in a demolition waste land-fill)
